DIAL-4 Screening

Schedule your child for a free standardized assessment of skills with the DIAL 4 Screening. This screening is available for children 3 years old to kindergarten entrance. Be informed about your child's development in the areas of speech and language, pre-academic, fine and gross motor, personal-social, hearing and vision. Appointments take approximately one hour and are held at the John Cary Early Childhood Center at 3155 Koch Road 63125. We are now scheduling for February 2, February 16, February 23, March 8, March 29, April 19 and May 3, 2024.
