BEING ON TIME

Take Care of Each Other and Your School

Why it's important (drop off)

- models good habits for your children
- promotes consistency in everyday routines
- allows enough time for children to settle into class
- keeps them from missing any curricular activities
- prevents them from unexpectedly being the center of attention

Why it's important (pick up)

- establishes trusting relationship (children look forward to seeing their caregiver after school)
 - children can feel confused/upset when others are leaving class and they have to stay
 - allows ample time for the staff to prepare for the next session

AND READY FOR SCHOOL.

TIPS TO PROMOTE BEING ON TIME

- wake up five to ten minutes earlier
- set your clock ahead five minutes (house and car)
- time your morning routine and be aware of how much time you need
- keep your "get ready" routine consistent for your child
- prepare the night before: pick out clothes, set out backpack, choose and pack school snack
